Presidential Preference Primary – March 17, 2020

Primary Election August 25, 2020 - General Election November 3, 2020

(Election Dates Subject to Change)

Reports must be filed:

Monthly; On the 60th day immediately preceding the Election; Biweekly on each Friday thereafter;
Additional reports filed on the 25th, and 11th and, 4th days before the Election.

Penalty for Late Filing

Any candidate or committee failing to file a report on the designated due date shall be subject to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total contributions or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for pre-election reports, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total contributions or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. For Termination Reports the fine is \$50 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total contributions or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report.

Note: Candidates must dispose of all funds in the campaign account and file a Termination Report within 90 days after having withdrawn, become unopposed, eliminated or elected to office.



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Executive Committees 2019 Calendar of Reporting Dates

- Reports must be filed on the 10th day following the end of each calendar quarter.
- Reports must be filed the Friday prior to each Primary and General Election.

F.S. 106.29 (3)(b) Upon determining that a report is late, the filing officer shall immediately notify the chair of the executive committee or the leader of the affiliated party committee as defined in s. 103.092 as to the failure to file a report by the designated due date and that a fine is being assessed for each late day. The fine shall be \$50 for a county executive committee, per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, if an executive committee or an affiliated party committee fails to file a report on the Friday immediately preceding the special election or general election, the fine shall be \$10,000 per day for each day a state executive committee is late, \$10,000 per day for each day an affiliated party committee is late, and \$500 per day for each day a county executive committee is late. Upon receipt of the report, the filing officer shall determine the amount of the fine which is due and shall notify the chair or leader as defined in s. 103.092.
