Residency Requirements for Councilmembers and Mayor

Shall the Milton City Charter be amended to require candidates for City Council to reside within their respective wards for at least one year immediately prior to qualifying and to reduce the residency requirement for candidates for Mayor from three years to one year immediately prior to qualifying, to create uniformity in qualifying for the office of Mayor and Councilmember, and to clarify the residency period required.

When requesting a Vote-by-Mail ballot, voters must provide their name, date of birth, Florida driver's license, Florida ID number or last 4 of Social Security number, residence address and mailing address. In addition, the voter's signature is required for a written request. These requests must be received no later than Saturday, October 29, 2022 at 5 p.m. Voted ballots must be returned to the Supervisor of Elections Office no later than 7 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2022.

3. AT YOUR PRECINCT - Cast your ballot at your precinct on Election Day, using the DS200 optical scan machine. ExpressVote (touchscreen) machines are also available for persons with disabilities. On Tuesday, November 8, 2022 polls will be open from 7 a.m. until 7 p.m.

PLEASE NOTE: Changes in Florida Law regarding dropping off Vote-by-Mail Ballots for others:

Florida Statutes 104.0616 Vote-by-mail ballots and voting; violations:

(1) For purposes of this section, the term "immediate family" means a person's spouse or the parent, child, grandparent, grandchild, or sibling of the person or the person's spouse.

(2) Any person who distributes, orders, requests, collects, delivers, or otherwise physically possesses more than two vote-by-mail ballots per election in addition to his or her own ballot or a ballot belonging to an immediate family member, except as provided in ss. 101.6105-101.694, including supervised voting at assisted living facilities and nursing home facilities as authorized under s. 101.655, commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
