1. EARLY - Monday, August 8, 2022 through Saturday, August 20, 2022 voters may cast their ballot early at any one of six locations using the DS200 optical scan machine. ExpressVote (touchscreen) machines are also available for persons with disabilities. **Early voting hours are 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.**

2. BY MAIL - Any voter may request a vote-by-mail ballot by contacting the Supervisor of Elections Office by mail, by phone (850) 983-1900, by e-mail: kirsting@santarosa.fl.gov, by fax (850) 983-1829, online at www.votesantarosa.gov, or in person at the Supervisor of Elections Office located at 6495 Caroline St, Suite F, Milton, FL 32570. When requesting a vote-by-mail ballot, voters must provide their name, date of birth, Florida driver's license number, Florida ID number or last 4 of Social Security, residence address and mailing address. In addition, the voter's signature is required for a written request. These requests must be **received no later than Saturday, August 13, 2022 at 5 p.m.** Voted ballots must be returned to the Supervisor of Elections Office no later than 7 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, August 23, 2022.

3. AT YOUR PRECINCT - Cast your ballot at your precinct on Election Day, using the DS200 optical scan machine. ExpressVote (touchscreen) machines are also available for persons with disabilities. On **Tuesday, August 23, 2022** polls will be open from 7 a.m. until 7 p.m.

PLEASE NOTE: Changes in Florida Law regarding dropping off Vote-by-Mail Ballots for others:

Florida Statutes 104.0616 Vote-by-mail ballots and voting; violations:

- (1) For purposes of this section, the term "immediate family" means a person's spouse or the parent, child, grandparent, grandchild, or sibling of the person or the person's spouse.
- (2) Any person who distributes, orders, requests, collects, delivers, or otherwise physically possesses more than two vote-by-mail ballots per election in addition to his or her own ballot or a ballot belonging to an immediate family member, except as provided in ss. 101.6105-101.694, including supervised voting at assisted living facilities and nursing home facilities as authorized under s. 101.655, commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
