- Signs may only be placed on County property during early voting dates for those locations and only at precincts on election days. No signs may be placed within 150 feet of a secure ballot intake station or the entrance to any polling place, a polling room where the polling place is also a polling room, an early voting site, or an office of the supervisor where vote-by-mail ballots are requested and printed on demand for the convenience of electors who appear in person to request them, as outlined in F.S.102.031 Section (4)(a).
- 2. No trailers can be left on County property.
- 3. No overnight vehicle parking.
- 4. Only one sign per candidate, per voting location.
- 5. No signs in County right of way.
- 6. Signs cannot be larger than 18" x 24".
